Dual diagnosis is a term used to describe a person who is diagnosed with a mental illness a substance use or abuse and disorder at the same time More than half of persons who have a serious mental illness also have a substance use or abuse disorder Dual diagnosis is sometime referred to as co-occurring disorders or comorbidity
